

The University of British Columbia is pleased to offer 1 re-entry residency training position in Anesthesiology for the academic year commencing July 1, 2009. **This position is for a maximum of 3 years of training, and so only those candidates who have had one year of anaesthesiology residency in a program recognized by the RCPSC should apply (eg those who are have had the one year Family Practice Anesthesiology training).**

Eligible applicants must:

1. Be a Canadian Citizen or landed immigrant at time of application.
2. Currently be fully licensed (not on the special registry) in the province which they reside.
3. Not currently enrolled in a residency training program.

Interested applicants should forward a completed application form (available from Ms. Susan Van Bruggen, phone 604 875 4111 local 68430 or email susan.vanbruggen@vch.ca), current CV, a personal letter, and three (3) letters of reference.

The personal letter should list three attributes or characteristics which best describe you as an individual, and how you feel any/all of these attributes are relevant to the field of anesthesiology. Please also provide a single example from personal experience which demonstrates this personal attribute or characteristic. This should be on no more than 1 typed page.

Three letters of reference are required. Additional letters of reference are optional; additional letters do not confer any advantage or disadvantage. One reference letter should be from an anesthesiologist. One letter should be from a supervisor who is familiar with your Family Practice Anesthesiology training; this may be combined with the previous requirement for a letter from an anesthesiologist. If this is not possible, this should be explained in the personal letter. Reference letters from members of the UBC Selection Committee will not be permitted for applications to the UBC Anesthesiology residency program.
